BARBARA B. SMITH '42 GRANT

This grant is made possible through a trust created by Pomona Music major Barbara B. Smith (1920-2021).

One of the early members of the Society for Ethnomusicology, Dr. Smith went on to establish non-Western music in the curriculum at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa and to mentor generations of scholars and world music educators. The grant is intended to support opportunities for experiencing off-campus instruction, workshops, and conferences in ethnomusicology and/or opportunities involving direct contact with non-Western music in settings beyond the college classroom.
